

MG 5 Park Hotel fonds

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of administrative and operational records created and used by the Park Hotel during its operations from 1947 to 2001.

Records include night audit journals (1954), reservation books (1947-1959), breakfast menus for the Park Hotel Coffee Shop (1958 -ca. 1960), room notices (1964), postcards (1964), and dancers regulations (2000) of the Park Hotel.

Authority Name Park Hotel

Authority History The Park Hotel was first constructed in 1902 as the Alexandra Hotel by Frederick Krause. Red Deer boomed in those early days and the Alexandra Hotel was extensively renovated and enlarged in 1911. The outbreak of the First World War and the onset of prohibition proved to be a disaster for the business and the hotel was forced to close.

The business was purchased in 1924 by Mr. and Mrs. W. L. McBride who renamed it the McBride Hotel. It was to be operated as a family hotel, without a bar, and with halls and rooms available for banquets, whist parties and teas.

In January 1926, the hotel was sold to Henry Busby who renamed it the Auditorium. The hotel became the bus terminal for Greyhound, Sorenson and Cardinal Bus lines.

In 1947, the Auditorium was remodeled and renamed the Park Hotel, under the ownership of the Calgary Brewing and Malting Company. Extensive renovations occurred in 1952. In 1964, following the passage of new provincial legislation prohibiting breweries from owning beer outlets, the hotel was sold by the Calgary Brewing and Malting Company to T and M Hotels Ltd. There was a brief name change to the Western Inn in 1982 with country entertainment as the feature. The name changed back to the Park Hotel in 1985, when exotic dancing was offered as entertainment. The hotel business closed in 2001 and the building was converted into a half way house by the John Howard Society
