Authority History The Red Deer Scout-Guide Association formed in 1949 to “create a public interest in Scout-Guide and Brownie and Cub activities.” The group was responsible for raising funds, publicity, increasing parental involvement and general assistance to youth members. They also were responsible for the maintenance of the Scout-Guide Hall, which was built in the late 1930s and burnt down in 1970s.

One of major fundraising campaigns was to canvas the local businesses for repairs and improvements to the Scout-Guide Hall. This was undertaken in 1949 and again in 1956.

The Association was disbanded in 1956, and responsibility for the organization was taken over by the Boy Scout District Council and the Girl Guides Local Association.
