We the undersigned merchants, traders, brokers, mechanics, manufacturers, managers of banks or insurance agents and residents of the Provincial Electoral District of Red Deer, in the Province of Alberta, hereby certify:

1. That the said Electoral District has a population in excess of two thousand five hundred people.
2. That we desire to form a Board of Trade under the provisions of Chapter 124 of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, 1906.
3. That the name assumed and by which it shall be known is "The Red Deer Board of Trade" and the District in which the same is situate and its business is to be transacted is the Electoral District of Red Deer.
4. That J. R. Davison of the Town of Red Deer aforesaid, Agent, is hereby appointed Secretary of the said Board of Trade.
5. That the objects for which incorporation is sought are those set out and defined by the said Act.
