Sign Bylaw Review Committee:


This committee was established in June 1995 to review The City's Sign Bylaw relative to location of signage on public and private property and related matter and is currently working towards that mandate.

Being a bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 3142/95, The Committees Bylaw of The City of Red Deer.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED DEER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Bylaw No. 3142/95 is hereby amended as follows:

- 2 By renumbering current sections 28(4) to 28(8), to read section 28(6) to 28(10), respectively.
