BY-LAW 2853/84

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**Being a By-law of The City of Red Deer  
with respect to smoking**

WHEREAS Section 112 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1980, Chapter M-26 provides as follows:

"A council may pass by-laws that are considered expedient and are not contrary to this or any other act, a) for the peace, order and good government of the municipality, b) for promoting the health, safety, morality and welfare thereof, and c) for governing the proceedings of the council, the conduct of its members and the calling of meetings."

AND WHEREAS Section 160(1)(a) states that:

"A council may pass by-laws preventing, and compelling the abatement of, nuisances generally, and regulating untidy and unsightly premises;"

AND WHEREAS it has been determined that second-hand tobacco smoke is a health hazard and a public nuisance because of its impairment, adverse affect and risk to health, to the inhabitants of the City of Red Deer;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable for the health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of The City of Red Deer to provide for regulating smoking and second-hand smoke for the better protection of persons from conditions injurious to health in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to provide for the prohibiting and abating of second-hand smoke in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED DEER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this bylaw,

(a) "City" means the City of Red Deer;

(b) "place of public assembly" means a building and all adjacent land areas owned or operated by the City, or a portion or portions thereof used for the gathering together of persons for such purposes as deliberation, entertainment, recreation, business or amusement;

(c) "second-hand smoke" means,
