Fonds consists of the administrative and operational records created, accumulated, and used by the Rotary Club of Red Deer while providing community service to the Central Alberta area.

Rotary activities were guided by four main committees: Club, Vocation, Community, and International; and these governing themes are apparant in the records themselves. The types of records include the constitution and by-laws, minutes, correspondence, financial statements, membership rosters (1923-1974), committee minutes and reports, newsletters, Black Tie Bingo fundraiser records, fundraiser financial records, Rotary history books, and accounting ledgers.
