Authority Name Bundy, Eric

Authority History Eric Bundy was born in Regina, Saskatchewan in 1925. After completing Grade 11, he served one year in the Canadian Army during the Second World War. He worked for Simpson's department stores in Regina for 12 years, during which time he married Murial Whiting and they had one daughter. The family moved to Humboldt, Saskatchewan and Bundy took a correspondence course from the School of Creative Photography and began taking professional photographs.

In 1961, they moved to Red Deer, Alberta and Bundy opened his own photography studio in his home. He retired in 1990 but continued to do photography as a volunteer for the Red Deer Museum and Art Gallery, Red Deer Archives, and the Kerry Wood Nature Centre. Eric died in Red Deer, Alberta in 1990.
