We would like to provide you with another update on the progress of the 1998 Alberta Winter Games. With only 3.5 months until the athletes arrive the activity and planning has moved into high speed. Some of the Major updates include:

#### **Staff**

- Our organization now consists of 7 full time staff.
- The 1998 Alberta Winter Games boasts one of the lowest staff budgets in recent Games history.

#### **Volunteers**

- Our volunteer base continues to grow. Our 14 Directors are joined by 85 Chairpeople who are working daily on the plans to welcome over 2700 athletes, coaches and officials.
- The Games are anticipating a need for 3000 enthusiastic volunteers to assist in the preparations and work in a wide variety of opportunities.

#### **Facilities**

- All of our facilities have been booked and all sports will take place in Red Deer except for hockey, which will be split between the Kinsmen Arenas and Innisfail.

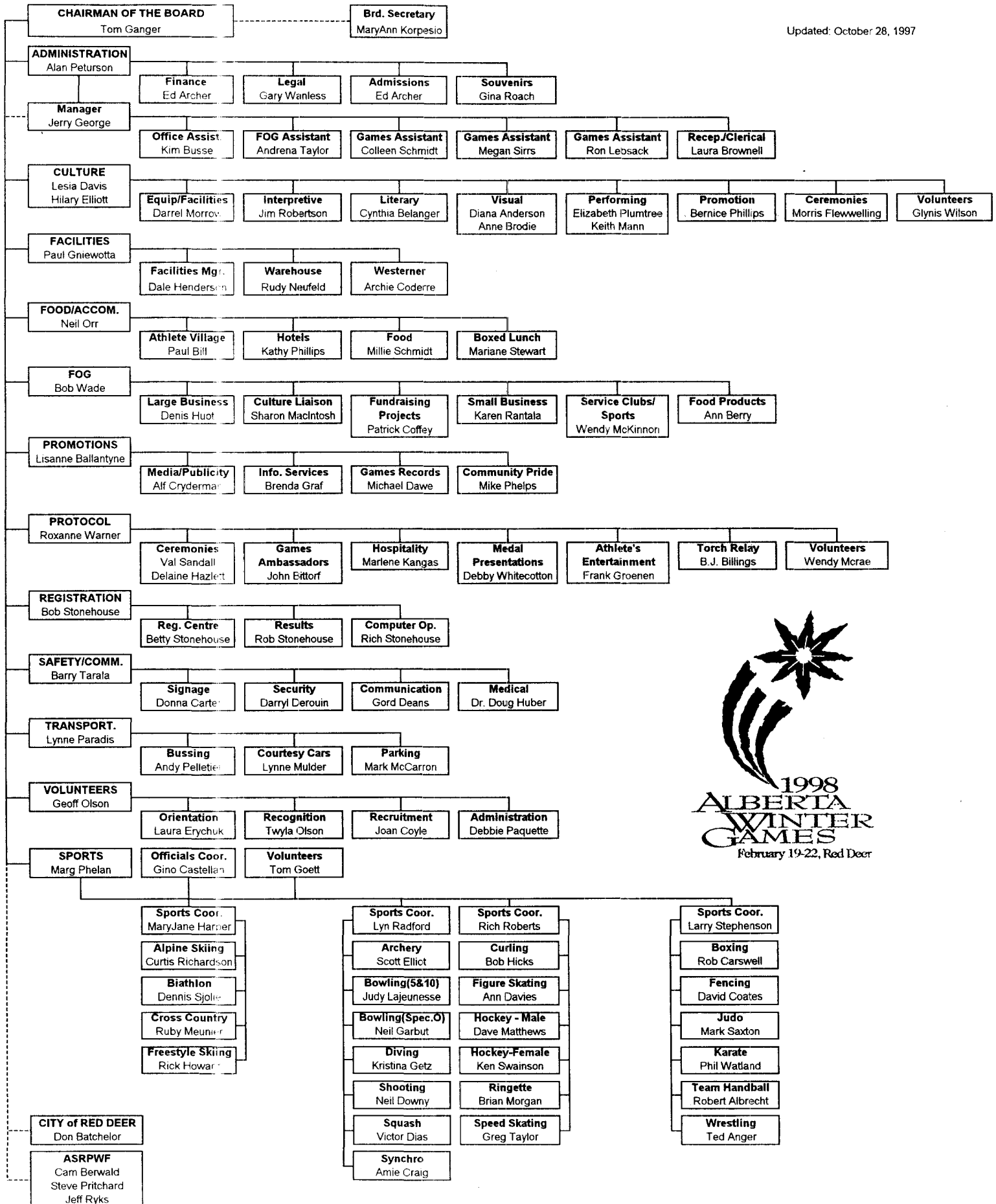





Dear Council,

The Board of Directors of the Red Deer Downtown Business Association are pleased to submit for your approval, our 1998 budget request. During budget design this year, we have discovered some very interesting facts regarding our budget, and I am pleased to provide these details for your information.

Since 1984, it is estimated that the private sector has invested a total of more than \$52,000,000.00 in new construction and renovations in the downtown district. Of these, the BRZ program has worked directly with an estimated 65% of private projects, by providing advice, letters of project support, facade concepts, and information to the developers on policies, zoning, and planning in the downtown. In this time frame the BRZ has cost an estimated \$1.01 million to operate, or 1.9% of the investment attracted. Over this same period the BRZ has leveraged funding to more than \$2.3 million, through contracts, sales of advertising and partnering.

The cost to our membership in 1998 can be accurately described as follows;

- 62% of the business membership contribute \$100 per year to the Association.
- 70% of the membership contribute less than \$10 per month to the Association.
- Since 1984, the member businesses of the Association have provided an average of 47% of the annual budget.
- Since 1988, increased revenues have been the result of business growth within the BRZ.
- The Association has absorbed an estimated 28% inflation since 1988.

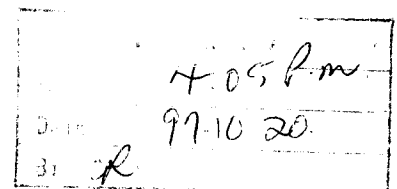
The Association is justifiably proud of this performance, and we are pleased to provide to you the 1998 budget request, which again contains no increases to the membership. In 1997, there were some increases to individuals, as a result of the City's new assessment, but overall the majority of members actually had no increase or minor decreases in BRZ tax paid.

The Board of Directors looks forward to another productive year in the economic growth of the Central Business District, and in further co-operative projects with the City of Red Deer.

Each item in the expense accounts contain percentages recommended by the accountant, for salaries and overhead so that the accounts reflect the true total cost of the categories. 100% of the litter staff wages are included in the litter budget figure.

In the category "Promotion, Advertising and Design", the Board of Directors has left projects for 1998 unspecified so that new directors to be appointed January '98 will have more opportunity to provide input and fresh insight to the years programming. All items under this category are deemed optional, excluding overhead costs, and specific projects are under constant review by the Board of Directors.

In addition to our budget as outlined, the Association will likely be taking advantage of bridge financing for the GHOST Project "Sound The Alarm", as approved by City Council in 1996. Council had approved bridge financing of up to \$85,000.00, with the Association making annual payments to the City from budgets occurring over the following six years. The Board of Directors remains confident that if financing is used, the Association will pay back the loan on an escalated payment schedule retiring the debt much sooner than originally planned.





Dear Council,

The Board of Directors of the Red Deer Downtown Business Association are pleased to submit for your approval, our 1998 budget request. During budget design this year, we have discovered some very interesting facts regarding our budget, and I am pleased to provide these details for your information.

Since 1984, it is estimated that the private sector has invested a total of more than \$52,000,000.00 in new construction and renovations in the downtown district. Of these, the BRZ program has worked directly with an estimated 65% of private projects, by providing advice, letters of project support, facade concepts, and information to the developers on policies, zoning, and planning in the downtown. In this time frame the BRZ has cost an estimated \$1.01 million to operate, or 1.9% of the investment attracted. Over this same period the BRZ has leveraged funding to more than \$2.3 million, through contracts, sales of advertising and partnering.

The cost to our membership in 1998 can be accurately described as follows;

- 62% of the business membership contribute \$100 per year to the Association.
- 70% of the membership contribute less than \$10 per month to the Association.
- Since 1984, the member businesses of the Association have provided an average of 47% of the annual budget.
- Since 1988, increased revenues have been the result of business growth within the BRZ.
- The Association has absorbed an estimated 28% inflation since 1988.

The Association is justifiably proud of this performance, and we are pleased to provide to you the 1998 budget request, which again contains no increases to the membership. In 1997, there were some increases to individuals, as a result of the City's new assessment, but overall the majority of members actually had no increase or minor decreases in BRZ tax paid.

The Board of Directors looks forward to another productive year in the economic growth of the Central Business District, and in further co-operative projects with the City of Red Deer.

As always the '98 budget will be adjusted as required to ensure a balanced budget. The contingency account in '98 will total \$28,000.00

Each item in the expense accounts contain percentages recommended by the accountant, for salaries and overhead so that the accounts reflect the true total cost of the categories. 100% of the litter staff wages are included in the litter budget figure.

In the category "Promotion, Advertising and Design", the Board of Directors has left projects for 1998 unspecified so that new directors to be appointed January '98 will have more opportunity to provide input and fresh insight to the years programming. All items under this category are deemed optional, excluding overhead costs, and specific projects are under constant review by the Board of Directors.

In addition to our budget as outlined, the Association will likely be taking advantage of bridge financing for the GHOST Project "Sound The Alarm", as approved by City Council in 1996. Council had approved bridge financing of up to \$85,000.00, with the Association making annual payments to the City from budgets occurring over the following six years. The Board of Directors remains confident that if financing is used, the Association will pay back the loan on an escalated payment schedule retiring the debt much sooner than originally planned.



To control litter onboard City Transit Vehicles we are requesting that the Nuisance Bylaw 3150/95 be amended to include Transit Vehicles. As well, the \$500 penalty would seem to be onerous and not appropriate for the severity within the public transportation environment. Our suggestion would be a fine of \$50.

Consumption of food and beverages on buses is currently discouraged. This is being revised to allow sealed beverages only, at the discretion and direction of the Transit Operator in charge. Our intention in this regard is to enhance customer service.

The following describes suggested wording and penalties:

Section 6 (1)

No person shall place, deposit or throw or cause to be placed, deposited or thrown upon any City property, including any street, lane, sidewalk, parking lot, park, public transportation vehicle, public transportation shelters, other public transportation facilities or other public place or water course...

Section 6 (2)

A person who has placed, deposited or thrown or caused to be placed or thrown anything or any matter mentioned in subsection (1) upon any street, lane, sidewalk, parking place, park, public transportation vehicle, public transportation shelter, public transportation facilities or other public place or water course shall forthwith remove it.

**Offenses and Penalties**

New section 10 - Public Transportation Vehicles, Shelters, Facilities

Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and shall be liable upon conviction to a specified penalty of \$50.00.

## **BYLAW NO. 3150/95**

Being a Bylaw of The City of Red Deer, in the Province of Alberta, to prevent and compel the abatement of nuisances generally, regulating unsightly and untidy premises;

WHEREAS under section 7(c) of the *Municipal Government Act*, a Council of the City may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting nuisances, including unsightly property;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED DEER, THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1            This Bylaw may be called the "Nuisance Bylaw".
- 2        (1)    "Director", for the purposes of this Bylaw, means the Director of Development Services, and any person designated to carry out any duties or functions to enforce this Bylaw;
- (2)    "Nuisance" for the purpose of this Bylaw means any use of or activity upon any property which is offensive to any person, or has or may have a detrimental impact upon any person or other property in the neighbourhood, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, includes the following:
  - (a)    the failure to cut grass or weeds;
  - (b)    the failure to destroy restricted weeds, control noxious weeds, or prevent the spread or scattering of nuisance weeds;
  - (c)    the growth of trees or shrubs in such a manner that they interfere with or endanger visibility to street signage or sidewalk roadway clearance;
  - (d)    the causing of opaque or dense smoke and permitting such smoke to be emitted into the atmosphere for a period in excess of 6 minutes

in any one hour, or at a point other than the opening to the atmosphere of the flue, stack or chimney, unless specifically authorized by Council;

- (e) the generation of excessive dust and permitting such dust to escape from the property;
- (f) the use of any pesticide or herbicide which has significant detrimental or environmental effects on surrounding areas;
- (g) the failure to control or eliminate insect pests harmful to the growth and development of trees and shrubs or any vegetable or plant life;
- (h) the storage or accumulation of dilapidated vehicles or the storage of vehicles in excess of the number of vehicles permitted under the Land Use Bylaw;
- (i) the storage or accumulation of or failure to dispose of discarded or dilapidated furniture or household appliances, scrap metals, scrap lumber, tires, and motor vehicle parts;
- (j) the failure to dispose of any rubbish or garbage accumulated upon any property.
- (k) the posting or exhibiting of posters, signs, billboards, placards, writings or pictures upon any fence or wall on any property, where the same are accumulated and become in a dilapidated and unsightly condition.

No person being the owner, agent of the owner, lessee or occupier of any property within the City shall permit such property, or the activities upon such property to be or remain a nuisance.

- 4 (1) The Director may, after giving reasonable notice to the owner or occupier of the premises, enter upon the said premises and carry out an inspection.
- (2) Upon completion of the inspection, the Director may direct the owner or occupant of the property to:
- (a) cease the activity which causes the nuisance;
  - (b) change the way in which such person is carrying out any activity;
  - (c) direct any person to take any action or measure necessary to compel the elimination or abatement of the nuisance, including the removal of any thing or matter from the property, which constitutes the nuisance;
  - (d) specify the time within which such person must comply with the directions contained in the notice; and
  - (e) notify the owner or occupant that, if compliance with the notice is not effected within a specified time, that the municipality will take the actions or measures specified in the notice to abate the nuisance, at the expense of the owner or occupier.
- 5 No person shall cause or permit or undertake any activity upon any City property which is a nuisance.
- 6 (1) No person shall place, deposit or throw or cause to be placed, deposited or thrown upon any City property, including any street, lane, sidewalk, parking lot, park or other public place or water course:
- (a) a cardboard or wooden box, carton, container, or receptacle of any kind;



- (b) a paper, wrapper, envelope, or covering of any kind, whether paper or not, from food or confectionery;
  - (c) paper of any kind, whether or not containing written or printed matter thereon;
  - (d) any human, animal or vegetable matter or waste;
  - (e) any glass, crockery, nails, tacks, barbed-wire or other breakable or sharp objects;
  - (f) scrap metal, scrap lumber, tires, dismantled wrecked or dilapidated motor vehicles or parts therefrom;
  - (g) any motor vehicle or any part of any motor vehicle which may, in whole or in part, obstruct any highway, street, lane, alley, bi-way or other public place;
  - (h) dirt, filth or rubbish of any kind whether similar or dissimilar to the foregoing.
- (2) A person who has placed, deposited or thrown or caused to be placed or thrown anything or any matter mentioned in subsection (1) upon any street, lane, sidewalk, parking place, park or other public place or water course shall forthwith remove it.

No person shall place, deposit or throw or cause to be placed, deposited or thrown upon or into any motor vehicle, which is parked on any street, lane, parking lot or other public place, any leaflet, pamphlet, poster, handbill, flyer or any paper containing printed or written matter, whether advertising or not, with the exception of any violation ticket or summons issued pursuant to lawful authority.

- 8           The Director may authorize any City employee, or other person, to remove and put in storage or destroy anything placed upon City property in contravention of Section 5 and 6 of this Bylaw.

## **OFFENSES AND PENALTIES**

- 9           Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and shall be liable upon conviction to a specified penalty of \$500.00.
- 10          Where a Bylaw Enforcement Officer has reasonable grounds to believe that a person has contravened any provisions of this Bylaw, such Officer may serve upon such person an Offense Ticket allowing payment of the specified penalty to the City, which payment shall be accepted by the City in lieu of prosecution for the offense.
- 11          Bylaw No. 3034/91 is hereby repealed.



At the meeting of the Red Deer Policing Committee held on September 23, 1997, consideration was given to a request from Mr. Gene Ajas of Eagle Eye Graphics regarding advertising on the rear and side rear windows of taxi cabs. The correspondence received from Mr. Ajas is attached for your reference.

Mr. Ajas is requesting a change to the current Taxi Bylaw which would allow for a product referred to as Clear Vision Window Vinyl, to be placed on the rear and side rear windows of taxi cabs to provide for advertising of businesses. The Committee reviewed this item with Mr. Ajas, and was not opposed to the idea of providing this type of advertising on taxi cabs, but they did feel that more research into this form of advertising needed to be done. They understood from Mr. Ajas that currently Calgary and Edmonton have Bylaws that permit this type of advertising. The Committee was concerned with the safety aspect of this advertising on windows, and also felt the need for controls to be put into place. It would be important to ensure that this type of advertising complies with the Highway Traffic Act. It was also felt that currently, there is a great deal of visual pollution of advertising within the city.

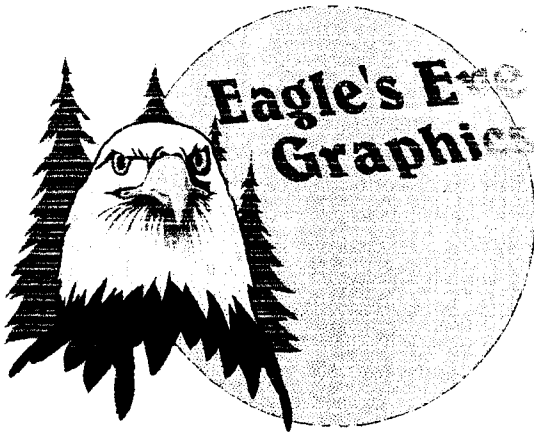
### RECOMMENDATION

The Committee would recommend that following a review of the Calgary and Edmonton Bylaws and comments from the taxi industry, that a change be made to the Taxi Bylaw to allow for Clear Vision Window Vinyl Advertising, subject to a six month trial period to test this type of advertising to ensure that it is appropriate within the city of Red Deer.




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In response to your memo of October 9, 1997, regarding the above referenced, we have the following comments for Council's consideration.

A presentation was made at the taxi commission meeting of September 23 requesting a bylaw change to the taxi business bylaw to permit window graphics on the rear and rear side windows of taxis.

Mr. Ajas of Eagle's Eye Graphics indicated this type of advertising was already being sold in Edmonton and Calgary with no safety problems emerging.

My investigations revealed the Calgary Taxi Commission dealt with a similar request about 3 months earlier and denied said application citing safety concerns. The Edmonton Taxi Commission has permitted "advison" since 1992 but all ads must be approved by the commission on an individual basis.

Since many taxis operating in Red Deer already have their rear and rear side windows darkened, the RCMP did not have any concerns with the addition of advertising graphics as the Highway Traffic Act does not regulate the windows to the rear of the driver. Given other business and private vehicles are not restricted, I am willing to support this request provided some control is maintained over the content of the advertising.

I have reviewed the correspondence pertaining to the addition of clear vision window vinyl advertising to the taxi cabs of this city.

The only concern to this office would be any offences that may be incurred under the provisions of the Highway Traffic Act. In particular, this type of advertising would come under the category of window tinting, Section 56.

In short, providing there are side view mirrors, tinting may be applied to windows behind that of the driver. For example, if you own a four door sedan you could apply the tint to the rear two doors and back window. Other than the band of tint in the top 4" - 6" of the front windshield, no tinting may be applied to the windshield, drivers nor front passenger door windows.

My only other concern is that in recent years cab drivers have almost on a yearly basis complained to the media and thereby the public about their safety. With the application of this type of material to their cab windows, it will be extremely difficult for passing motorists to notice if the driver is in any form of difficulty with their fair, i.e. a fight or robbery. I feel the taxi operators should be cognizant of this potential hazard.



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

## **BYLAW NO. 2393/72**

Being a bylaw to prohibit the discharge of guns or other firearms in specified parts of The City of Red Deer.

### **COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED DEER ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1<sup>1</sup>        The discharge of guns or other firearms in all parts of the City other than those portions zoned A1 agricultural (farming) zone under the Land Use Bylaw of the City is prohibited.
- 2        This bylaw shall not apply to Peace Officers, engaged in the execution of their duty, or to any other person or club specifically authorized in writing by the City Commissioners. Such authorization may be granted for the purpose of pest control, scientific research, archery and gun practice for organized groups on an approved site, or other activities of a similar nature and kind. An appeal lies to City Council from a refusal by the City Commissioners to grant such authorization.
- 3        Bylaw No. 2135 is repealed.
- 4        This Bylaw shall come into force upon the final passing hereof.

BYLAW NO. 2393/72

Being a bylaw to prohibit the discharge of any firearms or weapons within the Corporate Boundaries of the City of Red Deer.

DEFINITION: For the purposes of this Bylaw, Firearm shall mean any weapon from which any shot, bullet, or other projectile can be discharged and is capable of causing bodily injury or death to a person and includes those weapons commonly referred to as air guns, air rifles, air pistols, B.B. guns, sling shots, all types of Archery Equipment, and gas powered guns.

- 1) No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any Firearm within the Corporate Limits of the City of Red Deer.
- 2) No person shall transport by any means of conveyance any loaded firearm within the Corporate Limits of the City of Red Deer.
- 3) This Bylaw shall not apply to a Peace Officer or a class of persons who require the use of firearms to carry out the responsibilities of their lawful occupation.
- 4) The Chief of Police or City Commissioners may, in writing, authorize the use of Firearms for Pest Control, scientific research, archery & firearm practice, Historic events or other activities of a similar kind and nature.

5) A request for authorization to discharge firearms in the City of Red Deer must be made in writing to the City of Red Deer and must indicate the nature of the event, the location, dates, times, and the Name(s) of the Group and individuals who will be using the firearms for the purpose indicated.

6) The City of Red Deer reserves the right to refuse to issue a permit for good and sufficient reason and the Applicant(s) have the right to Appeal the refusal with the City of Red Deer Council.

## PENALTIES

Any person who contravenes any provision of this Bylaw shall be liable to a penalty of \$100.00 payable to the City of Red Deer.

## SEIZURE

A Peace Officer or Special Constable in and for the City of Red Deer may seize without warrant any firearm(s) which have been used in contravention of this Bylaw. Firearms seized under this Bylaw may be subject to forfeiture or destruction.


Thank you for your correspondence of September 22, 1997.



We support the idea of changing the addressing of the four properties mentioned. The fact that these properties face a separate road from 43 Avenue makes the present addressing confusing.

We do have concerns with the proposed name of Grandview Lane for a number of reasons:

- The City does not use the word lane to describe roadways in The City.
- There is presently a Grandview Boulevard and it has been recent practice in The City to avoid using the same name to label two different roadways although this was done in the past. By maintaining distinct names it reduces the likelihood of a caller or an emergency responder confusing different locations with the same name.
- Despite the fact there is an existing Grandview Boulevard this name would not presently be approved as The City has tried to be very consistent in maintaining subdivisions where all the streets in a subdivision and ONLY streets within that subdivision start with the same letter. The area for streets starting with "G" is Glendale.
- We would suggest that a better name for this street would be simply 45 Street or 45 Street Close as it is virtually a physical extension of the existing 45 Street.

The City is working very hard to maintain an addressing system that is consistent and provides emergency callers and responders with the most consistent and logical means of identifying properties. There are some existing anomalies in the system but The City should be working to reduce these rather than increase them.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

The Emergency Services Department respectfully recommends to Council that the requested name change not be granted and the street be renamed 45 Street Close.



5. Canada Post has agreed to the name change. The postal code would remain unchanged.

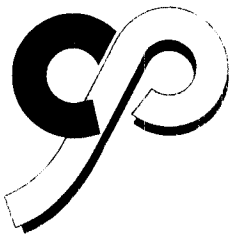

Planning staff have reviewed the request for a street name change and provide the following comments:

- ◆ The existing properties are presently addressed 4408, 4410, 4416 – 43 Avenue. A name change may require re-addressing of the properties as 2, 6, 10, 16 – Grandview Lane, as the street or close is on the west side of the street the numbers will be even and is increased from south to north.
- ◆ When the subject area was subdivided and registered at land titles, the newly created road was registered as 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, in keeping was the street naming policy that a cul-de-sac with seven or less lots should carry the name of the street which provide it with access. Examples of this policy are Kemp Avenue, Denison Crescent, Doran Crescent, Duncan Crescent, etc. as shown on the attached plans.

Recommendation

Planning staff does not support the request for the street name change as the request does not comply to the Street Naming policy that any short cul-de-sac or close with seven or less lots should carry the name of the street which provides access.

**BYLAW NO. 3191/97**

Being a bylaw of the City of Red Deer, in the Province of Alberta, to prohibit the discharge of any firearms or weapons within the corporate boundaries of the City of Red Deer;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED DEER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1           This bylaw may be called the "Firearms Bylaw".

**DEFINITIONS**

2           "Firearms" for the purpose of this bylaw, shall mean any weapon from which any shot, bullet, or other projectile can be discharged and is capable of causing bodily injury or death to a person and includes those weapons commonly referred to as air guns, air rifles, air pistols, B. B. guns, sling shots, all types of archery equipment, and gas powered guns.

3           No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any firearm within the corporate limits of the City.

4           No person shall transport by any means of conveyance any loaded firearm within the corporate limits of the City.

5           This bylaw shall not apply to a Peace Officer or a class of persons who require the use of firearms to carry out the responsibilities of their lawful occupation.

- 6 (1) The City Manager may, in writing, authorize the use of firearms for pest control, scientific research, archery and firearm practice, historic events or other activities of a similar kind and nature, on such terms and conditions and subject to such restrictions which he deems necessary or advisable.
- (2) The City Manager shall notify the Chief of Police of any authorization given for the use of firearms.
- 7 A request for authorization to discharge firearms must be made in writing to the City Manager and must indicate the nature of the event, the location, dates, times and the name(s) of the group and individuals who will be using the firearms for the purpose indicated.
- 8 (1) The City Manager, acting reasonably, may refuse to issue a permit.
- (2) The Applicant(s) may appeal the refusal to issue a permit to City Council.

#### OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

- 9 Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall pay a specified penalty of \$100.00.

#### AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE TICKETS

- 10 A Peace Officer, on reasonable and probable grounds, believing an offence has been committed, may issue an offence ticket.

11 Bylaw No. 2393/72 is hereby repealed.




