**Authority History** Carl Morkeberg, 1903-1981, was born and educated in Markerville, Alberta. He was a butter maker, and he took over the proprietorship of the Markerville Creamery from his father Dan Morkeberg in 1930. He ran the Markerville Creamery for almost 42 years until he retired and closed the business on 15 Sept. 1972.

He married Marion Miles in 1930. They had 4 children: Lois, Val, Dana, and Adele. Carl Morkeberg was active in the local community; he was a Freemason with the Innisfail Lodge No. 8 and was the author of a history of Markerville
